COVID - 19

Sound Department Precautions during the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Being responsible and prepared is vital to keep everyone on set healthy. Below are a few guidelines I will be following for the foreseeable future. Making sure that talent is comfortable with our efforts to maintain a clean and safe working environment.

- Production and AD's should be aware that additional time may be necessary setup equipment, install and remove transmitters and lavalier microphones on talent, while following health and safety protocols.
- All kit, including transmitters and microphones will be cleaned and sanitized after every shoot day.
- As a general rule, 70% Isopropyl alcohol solution is used for the disinfection and cleaning of sound equipment.
- Prepackaged, individual disposable wipes, containing 70% alcohol are also used.
- Radio microphone transmitters and microphones will be cleaned and sanitised before and after each
 use. Where possible the same transmitter and microphone will be used for only one person.
- Any devices attached to another department's equipment (e.g.; Camera feeds, timecode syncs, etc) will also be cleaned and sanitised before and after each use.

On set recording:

- If radio microphones are necessary then the following precautions will be taken:
- · Face masks will be worn at all times.
- Gloves and safety glasses will be used if necessary.
- As mentioned above, the transmitter and mic will be sanitised before use.
- No sound equipment should be handled by any person from another department. Talent should be brought to the sound department for wiring.

<u>Head</u>phones:

- Anyone needing to listen on set using provided IEM receivers or via headphone distribution should provide their own headphones.
- HEADPHONES SHOULD NOT BE SHARED.

- Isopropyl Alcohol 70% (in spray canister)
- · Alcohol prep pads
- Cleaning wipes
- Masks
- Gloves
- Safety glasses
